### **LENT** is almost upon us!

**Ash Wednesday is 14<sup>th</sup> February** this year and marks the beginning of Lent. Shall we have a Lent Group this year?

Beyond worship and sermons in particular, there are few regular opportunities to deepen our faith. Participating in a Lent group is a great way to learn, share and refresh your spiritual life at a very important stage in the church's liturgical year.

A Lent Group takes time to prepare, and so before we take it any further I need to be sure that if a Lent course is made available that it will be well supported. Experience tells me that we need a group of 10-12 people to produce a regular group of 6-8 people each week, and that this is the minimum to enable a group to thrive. I have four main questions:

- 1. Would you join a group if the time worked for you?
- 2. Would you prefer afternoon or evening, in person or on zoom?
- 3. If in person, are you prepared to car share and travel across town to a church other than your own?
- 4. Would you prefer a course rooted in scripture or something broader in scope?

Attendance every week is ideal but not essential. There are likely to be five sessions. Please let me know your thoughts by phone or email. I will make a decision based on the responses received.

#### A MESSAGE FROM KERSTIN MACDONALD

Dear Friends,

This message, for once, isn't about Messy Church but more of a message of thanks.

A few years ago, when I received my certificate for ALM Worship leader in Worcester cathedral, I felt that Authorized Lay Ministry might not to be the end of my journey. However, I just didn't quite know where to go next.

As I started growing in my role as ALM within St. Godwald's I continued to feel that God was calling me to explore other routes and some of you have also asked and encouraged me to do so in your own ways. So, for the last 1.5 years I have been regularly meeting with the Diocesan Director of Vocation to explore this call closer and discern where God might be calling me to. As it stands currently, I think God might be calling me to pursue training to ordained ministry. I have completed a Stage One Interview Panel and am currently working towards the Stage 2 Bishops Advisory Panel with a lot of discernment, learning and training ahead, if this is God's plan for me.

Your general help and support (even though you may have been unaware of all of this), and the encouragement, support and prayers of David and Richard have been integral part of my discernment journey. From the bottom of my heart, I thank you all for the love you have shown me to grow in faith with you, and for the little nudges you gave me to hear Gods voice in my life.
