Lent Discussion Course at All Saints' Church

<u>Lent 2020 - Come and See</u>: this Lent we are encouraging you to invite someone you know to come along to a church service or event that they don't normally attend. This might be a member of the church community, neighbour or friend. There are postcards at the back of church to help you do this. As we all know, to receive a personal invitation is a precious gift; let's try to embrace this invitational approach to church life as part of our Lenten discipline this year.

Communion while there is a risk of coronavirus infection: An important instruction from the bishops

Communicants may take the bread (the wafer) only or the bread plus the wine sipped from the chalice - either counts as taking Communion. Dipping the wafer in the wine (intinction) is not advised except in the rare case of people not being able to sip from the chalice. The practice of intinction is never recommended, even at times when there is no special health risk, since there is a greater chance of passing on disease. General advice to protect yourself and everyone else is to wash your hands frequently with soap for 20 seconds; use a tissue to blow your nose or if you sneeze or cough, and dispose of it to a bin as soon as possible (not to the wastepaper bin in the vestry!).
