Some matches and a candle or nightlight will enable you to light it towards the end of the service as a mark of discipleship. The sermon will be sent out after the service.

Canon Owen Vigeon: With sadness we report the death of Canon Owen Vigeon. Owen was widely known across Bromsgrove and particularly at All Saints. When he retired, Owen chose to come to Bromsgrove as a place where he thought there would be few retired priests and where he would be of help and could continue his ministry. He and his wife Sally quickly became much loved members of the All Saints' community. We were inspired and moved by his sermons, his poems and reminiscences and his uniquely challenging Christmas and Easter cards. Some of his poems appeared in the All Saints' magazine. During an interregnum, Owen helped All Saints to move to using Common Worship. Sue Ward and Tessa Carrick were churchwardens at that time and had the privilege of working closely with him and learning from his wise counsel. When one of his daughters produced a granddaughter, Owen and Sally moved to Coventry to give the family support. He continued an active and generous ministry there. Sally died a little while ago and recently Owen moved into a care home. Owen, Rest in Peace.
