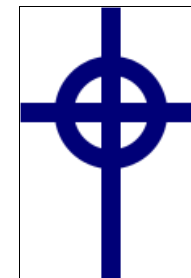

Rev. David Ford writes:

Our service Sunday 16th morning will come from St Godwald's Church for the first time since the pandemic began – and it coincides with the Dedication Anniversary of the Church! Our theme will be 'Listen and Understand', a theme taken from the gospel reading of the day – Matthew 15.10-28. In the afternoon, our 4pm quiet service will be in the tradition of the Iona Community and feature the hymns of John Bell and Graham Moule.



When next attending a zoom service you may notice that the 'chat' facility is disabled. This is to discourage 'chatting' during the service which can be distracting to others. A reminder too that switching from 'gallery' to 'speaker' view will also help you focus on those leading the worship rather than the congregation. After all, we don't sit in church facing one another! Thanks for your co-operation as we continue to learn together how to worship in new ways.

Everyone will need to self-distance at 2 metres.

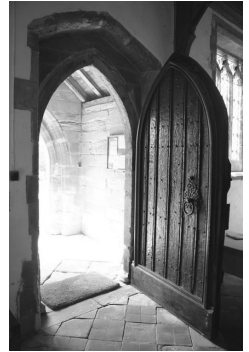
Numbers at any one time will be limited.
