### Have you seen the Bromsgrove Ravens?


A pair are flying around and are often seen or heard with their deep honking near All Saints' Church.

## The Good Shepherd window

Immediately opposite the south door, when you enter All Saints' Church, you see the striking Good Shepherd window. It was given by Miss Day in memory of her mother Catherine Elizabeth Day. The Days lived in Davenall House, now the doctor's surgery on the Birmingham Road.

The window, designed by Hardmans of Birmingham in 1898, shows Christ tenderly holding a lamb. Unfortunately, damage to the window means that the inscription has gone, but the dedication read, "To the glory of God and in loving memory of Catherine Elizabeth Day who died February 21 1886"

Miss Day herself played a big part in parish life, helping with the Parish teas and sales of work, acting as a District Visitor in the Strand area and contributing to numerous parish funds.
