Hello lovely people! When we started this asylum seeker support group I think most of us assumed the asylum seekers would be at the hotel for just a few months whilst Covid was sorted of course that has not happened and realistically it's not going to be safe for them to return to detention centres or other accommodation for the foreseeable future. Many of our asylum seekers would like to learn English and there is the possibility of setting up some external (covid-compliant) classes in conjunction with our friends at BRWR (Bromsgrove and Redditch Welcomes Refugees) who are already doing something similar for settled refugees. We are looking for a volunteer to take on co-ordinating this in partnership with BRWR. It will be a very rewarding task. Thank you....
