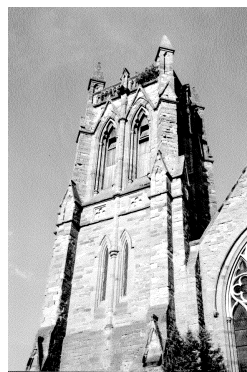

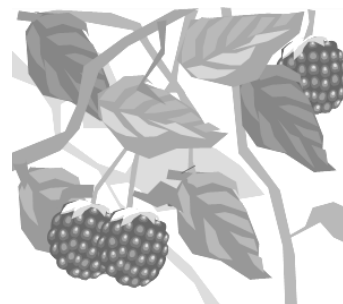
### **Harvest Auction:**
