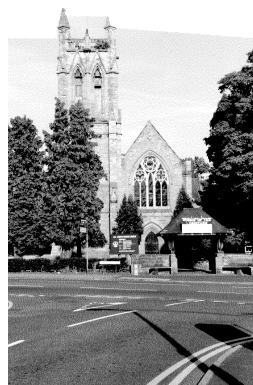

The Chatterty Meetings in the Church Hall:

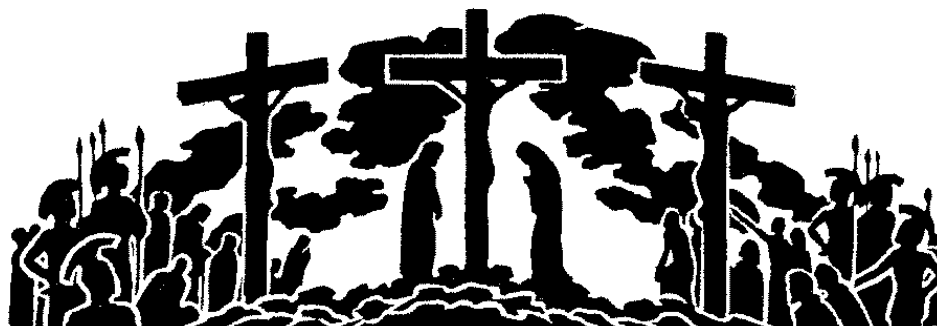
