

This year we celebrate 30 years since the first women were ordained as priests in the Church of England.

To mark this important moment, we would like to invite you to a special service in Pershore Abbey. We will celebrate with gratitude, the ministry of women past and present and pray for their continued ministry.

The service is on June 20th at 7 pm. It will be led by the Reverend Becky Elliott, Dean of Women's Ministry, and the Reverend Canon Claire Lording, Vicar of the Pershore Benefice. The Right Reverend Dr John Inge, Bishop of Worcester, will preach. There will be interviews with one of the first women ordained in our diocese as well as one of the most recently ordained.
