Unfortunately, on this occasion there was a breakdown with their relationship, which resulted in the young person returning to the project quite distressed. Staff were able to support the young person, invite them to join in on the Christmas lunch, which was appreciated enabling the young person to enjoy the company with other residents and staff.

Judith and David have supported our project for many years now and through their continuous fundraising and promotion of St Basils, our residents have been able to benefit from treats and help towards other costs that they would not have been able to afford from their benefits. It makes such a huge difference being able to offer help when needed. Many thanks to everyone from residents and staff at St Basils.
